ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2403E and R-2403-A, Continental Oil Company has made application to the Commission on April 10, 1974, for permission to expand its MCA Unit Area Water Flood Project in the Maljamar Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 11th day of April, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other offset operators;
3. That the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2403-A may be waived;
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2403-A;
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Baish "A" Well No. 1, located in Unit F of Section 21,  
Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County.
