ORDER WFX NO. 420

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4629, Continental Oil Company has made application to the Commission on December 18, 1974, for permission to expand its North El Mar Unit Water Flood Project in the El Mar-Delaware Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 31st day of December, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other offset operators.
3. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-4629.
4. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
5. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Delaware Sand formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

North El Mar Unit Well No. 58,
located in Unit D, Section 36,
Township 26 South, Range 32
East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
