ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4875, Northern Minerals, Inc. has made application to the Commission on February 14, 1975, for permission to expand its Northern Minerals McKinley Gallup Water Flood Project in the Miguel Creek-Gallup Oil Pool, McKinley County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 19th day of February, 1975, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no offset operators.
3. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-4875.
4. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
5. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Northern Minerals, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gallup formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Well No. 15, located
2405 feet from the North line and 2805 feet
from the East line of Section 29, Township 16
North, Range 6 West, NMPM, McKinley County,
New Mexico.
