ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4680, Skelly Oil Company has made application to the Commission on July 7, 1975, for permission to expand its Skelly Myers Langlie Mattix Unit Waterflood Project in the Langlie-Mattix Pool in Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 22nd day of July, 1975, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-4680.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-4680.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced waterflood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.
