ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4022 and R-4022A, Reserve Oil and Gas Company has made application to the Commission on June 16, 1975, for permission to expand its Reserve South Langlie-Jal Jalmat Water Flood Project in the Jalmat Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 16th day of July, 1975, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Oil Conservation Commission Rule 701-E.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-4022.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Reserve Oil and Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Seven Rivers and Queen formations through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

South Langlie-Jal Unit Well
No. 24 located in Unit O
of Section 18, and South Langlie-
Jal Unit Well No. 26 located in
Unit M of Section 17, both in
Township 25 South, Range 37 East,
NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
