ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3001, Mobil Oil Corporation has made application to the Commission on February 7, 1977, for permission to expand its Denton North Wolfcamp Unit Water Flood Project in the Denton-Wolfcamp Pool in Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 9th day of February, 1977, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other offset operators.
3. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3001.
4. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
5. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Mobil Oil Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Wolfcamp formation through plastic-lined tubing set in a packer at approximately 9058 feet in the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Denton North Wolfcamp Unit Tract 5 Well No.
10 located in Unit K of Section 35, Township
14 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County,
New Mexico.
