ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-5010, McClellan Oil Corporation has made application to the Commission on January 21, 1977, for permission to expand its East Henshaw Unit Water Flood Project in the West Henshaw-Grayburg Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 28th day of February, 1977, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other offset operators.
3. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-5010.
4. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
5. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, McClellan Oil Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg formation through tubing set in a packer at approximately 2980 feet in the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

East Henshaw Unit Tract 18 Well No. 4 located in
Unit N of Section 1, Township 16 South, Range 30
East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
