ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. 9-5010, McClellan Oil Corporation has made application to the Commission on January 21, 1977, for permission to expand its East Henshaw Unit Water Flood Project in the Mest Benshaw-Grayburg Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 28th day of February, 1977, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other offset operators.
- 3. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-5010.
- 4. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 5. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, McClellan Oil Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gravburg formation through tubing set in a packer at approximately 2990 feet in the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

East Henshaw Unit Tract 18 Well No. 4 located in Unit N of Section 1, Township 16 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
