Dear Mr. Duncan:

Reference is made to your request dated October 7, 1992, to increase the surface injection pressure on the Myers Langlie Mattix Unit No. 16. This request is based on a step rate tests conducted on the well on October 5, 1992. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on the well is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

Myers Langlie Mattix Unit No. 16 Unit H, Section 30, Township 23 South, Range 37 East	860 PSIG

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
