Reference is made to your request dated February 16, 1995 to increase the surface injection pressure on 4 wells in the above referenced waterflood project. This request is based on step rate tests conducted between January 31 and February 3, 1995. The results of the tests have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on these wells is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following wells:


