(5) That the subject application should be approved and the project should be governed by the provisions of Rules 701, 702, and 703 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant, Shenandoah Oil Corporation, is hereby authorized to institute a waterflood project in the Maljamar Pool by the injection of water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following-described wells in Township 17 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico:


