APPLICATION OF HUMBLE OIL AND REFINING COMPANY TO EXPAND THE HORSESHOE-GALLUP PRESSURE MAINTENANCE PROJECT NO. 2 IN THE HORSESHOE-GALLUP OIL POOL IN SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

Administrative Order PMX NO. 1

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-1745, Humble Oil & Refining Company has made application to the Commission on September 16, 1960, for permission to expand the Horseshoe-Gallup Pressure Maintenance No. 2 Project Area and for the conversion of two wells to water injection in the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 17th day of October, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-1745.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-1745.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Humble Oil & Refining Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gallup formation through the following described wells for purposes of pressure maintenance, to wit:

Humble's Navajo "M" Well No. 2 located in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 5 and Humble's Navajo "M" Well No. 5 located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 5, both in Township 31 North, Range 17 West, NMPM.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That the Horseshoe-Gallup Pressure Maintenance Project No. 2 Project Area is hereby expanded to include the NE/4 of Section 5, Township 31 North, Range 17 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.
