ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2190, Aztec Oil & Gas Company has made application to the Commission on November 20, 1967, for permission to expand its Central Totah Unit Pressure Maintenance Project in the Totah-Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 3rd day of January, 1968, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2190.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2190.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gallup formation through the following-described wells for purposes of pressure maintenance, to wit:

Unit Well No. 6, located in Unit H of Section 28,
Unit Well No. 14, located in Unit G of Section 33,
Unit Well No. 20, located in Unit J of Section 34,
and Unit Well No. 22, located in Unit N of Sec-
tion 34, all in Township 29 North, Range 13 West,
NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set below 5500 feet in the production casing of said wells.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
