ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3181-A, Phillips Petroleum Company has made application to the Commission on June 20, 1972, for permission to expand its Vacuum Abo Pressure Maintenance Project in the Vacuum-Abo Reef Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 10th day of July, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3181-A.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to gas injection under the terms of Order No. R-3181-A.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Phillips Petroleum Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject gas into the upper portion of the Abo Reef formation through the casing-tubing annulus above a packer set at 8530 feet in the following described well for purposes of pressure maintenance to wit:

Vacuum Abo Unit Tract 13 Well No. 2 located in Unit D of
Section 4, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, NMPM.
