

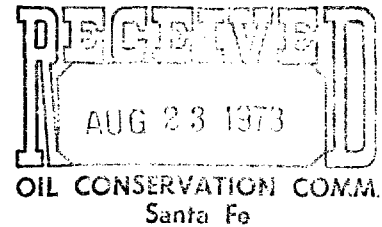

Arellano #1 $SE\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 5, T 24N, R 1E


