## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3456, Amoco Production Company has made application to the Commission on December 13, 1973, for permission to expand its Milnesand-Horton Pressure Maintenance Project in the Milnesand San Andres Pool, Roosevelt County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 2nd day of January, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3456.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3456.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
  - 6. That the application should be approved.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Amoco Production Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the San Andres formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Horton Federal Well No. 4 located in Unit F of Section 30, Township 8 South, Range 35 East, NMPM,

Horton Federal Well No. 11 located in Unit H of Section 30, Township 8 South, Range 35 East, NMPM.

## IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the project area is expanded to include:

The northwest quarter of the northwest quarter (NW/4 NW/4) of Section 29; the north half, plus the north half of the southwest quarter, plus the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter (N/2, N/2 SW/4 & NW/4 SE/4) of Section 30; all in Township 8 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Roosevelt County, New Mexico.
