ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4934, Amoco Production Company has made application to the Division on March 19, 1984, for permission to expand its South Hobbs (GSA) Pressure Maintenance Project in the Hobbs Grayburg-San Andres Pool in Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 9th day of April, 1984, the Division Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701B.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above referenced Pressure Maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Amoco Production Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formations through 2 3/8-inch plastic-lined tubing set in a packer at approximately 4,000 feet in the following described well for purposes of Pressure Maintenance to wit:
