Attached is a copy of an application by The Atlantic Refining Company to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission requesting permission to convert the Dickinson "A-13" No. 1 well, NW1NW1 Section 13, T15S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico, to a salt water disposal well in the Pennsylvanian formation. The application and notice of filing of application is the established procedure of the Commission.

Gonversion of this well is part of a salt water disposal project planned by the Denton operators to afford maximum protection of fresh water in the area. Informal approval of the conversion of the Dickinson "A-13" No. 1 to salt water disposal has been indicated by the NHOCC staff.

At present the Dickinson "A-13" No. 1 well is producing 100% salt water from the Wolfcamp formation which formerly produced oil. Upon conversion of this well, the water produced throughout the field will be disposed of into the Pennsylvanian formation, which is not productive of oil or gas in this area. Such a project will benefit the surface owners as well as the operators.

We would appreciate a letter from you waiving any objection to using the above well for this project. We have not settled as yet for the surface needed as the design work is not completed. Your waiver, of course, would be subject to a satisfactory settlement. Many matters have yet be worked out, but we must take this first step in getting the Commission proval before proceeding further.
