As requested by your application dated September 6, 1969, Administrative Order SWD-105 is hereby amended to read "to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Pennsylvanian formation at approximately 10,492 feet to approximately 10,620 feet through 2-inch tubing with a packer set at approximately 10,415 feet."

The subject order originally authorized the conversion of your State B-2330 Well No. 1 for the disposal of salt water into the Lower San Andres formation.
