Gentlemen:

In accordance with your request dated November 18, 1969, Administrative Order SWD-107 is hereby amended to read as follows:

IT IS THERFORE ORDERED:

"That the applicant herein, Union Oil Company of California, is hereby authorized to complete its Owens Well No. 2 located in Unit I of Section 34, Township 14 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the San Andres formation at approximately 4635 feet to approximately 6102 feet.

PROVIDED HIMENER, that the applicant shall treat the disposal water with an effective corrosion inhibitor and shall conduct coupon tests of the water continuously at the well head. The results of coupon tests shall be reported quarterly to the Secretary-Director of the Commission."
