THE APPLICATION OF PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY FOR A SALT WATER DISPOSAL WELL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-30 9, Phillips Petroleum Company, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 19, 1972, for permission to complete for salt water disposal its Philmex Well No. 9 located in Unit B of Section 26, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Order R-3079 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators, surface owners, and the New Mexico State Engineer Office have been duly notified; and

3. That the applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 (C) will be met.

4. That waivers of objection have been received from all offsetting operators and waiting period prescribed by said order may be despensed with in this instance.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Phillips Petroleum Company, is hereby authorized to complete its Philmex Well No. 9 located in Unit B of Section 26, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the San Andres formation at approximately 4960 feet to approximately 5090 feet through 2 3/8-inch plastic lined tubing with a packer set at approximately 4850 feet.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby gran ed in the interest of conservation. That applicant shall submit monthly reports of the disposal operation in accordance with Rules 704 and 1120 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.
