THE APPLICATION OF CORINNE GRACE  
FOR SALT WATER DISPOSAL WELL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701-C, Corinne Grace made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 26, 1973, for permission to complete for salt water disposal her Ranger Well No. 1 located in Unit H of Section 15, Township 12 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701-C of the Commission Rules and Regulations;
2. That inasmuch as there are no offset operators to the proposed well, immediate approval can be given.
3. That the applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed by Rule 701-C will be met.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


1. That the applicant herein Corinne Grace, is hereby authorized to complete her Ranger Well No. 1 located in Unit H of Section 15, Township 12 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Yates formation from approximately 2820 feet to approximately 2930 feet through 2 3/8 inch tubing.
2. That injection shall be through internally plastic-coated tubing after 90 days, and the casing tubing annulus shall be loaded with an inert fluid and equipped with a pressure gauge at the surface prior to placing the well on injection.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after notice and hearing, the the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted in the interest of conservation. That applicant shall submit monthly reports of the disposal operation in accordance with Rule 704 and 1120 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.
