Gentlemen:

You are hereby authorized to dispose of produced water from the Wilson Pool into the Wilson State Well No. 43 located in Unit J, Section 23, Township 21 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico, for a period not to exceed 90 days.

Injection is to be through plastic lined tubing below a packer set to a depth of at least 3250 feet. Surface injection pressure cannot exceed 740 psi.

If the information required in our Memo 3-77 is submitted prior to May 1, 1978, then permanent approval can probably be granted before the expiration of the 90 day period.

Dear Mr. Ramey;

Thank you for the temporary order regarding the subject case and order.

We have tabulated the requested data and schematics on wells within one-half mile of the subject well to be used for disposal of produced salt water.

To the best of my knowledge and belief the attached data is correct as taken from Wilson Oil Company and Commission files in Hobbs office.

One point of interest, the static water level in the Yates-Seven Rivers formations is no less than 1000' (from surface). The fresh shallow water occurs at depth shallower than the 1000' point.

Thus there is no chance for the Yates-Seven Rivers to enter the fresh water zones, in that our disposal system is set up on a gravity disposal.

We feel that the fresh shallow waters are fully protected. We will monitor the operations and if any problems arise they will be handled immediately with the Commission representative being advised.
