Dear Mr. Williams:

Reference is made to your request dated February 11, 2002, to increase the surface injection pressure on the above referenced well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on the well on February 7, 2002. After reviewing test results, we feel an increase in injection pressure is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

Well and Location	Maximum Surface Injection Pressure
Cotton Draw Unit Well No. 65	1,100 PSIG
Located in Unit G, Section 2, Township 25 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.	

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
