Ladies & Gentlemen:

New Mexico Salt Water Disposal Company, Inc. has filed the attached application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for a permit to dispose of produced salt water into the subject well. The well had previously been approved for disposal into the Bough "C" formation earlier this year, however, after receiving administrative approval and initiating injection into the Bough "C" formation, the casing collapsed at 7,100'. Without the disposal capacity of this well, New Mexico Salt Water Disposal Company, Inc. is suffering from a substantial decrease in revenue. For this reason we are filing the enclosed application to dispose of produced salt water into the San Andres formation.
