CORRECTED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER SWD-736

APPLICATION OF SANTA FE ENERGY RESOURCES, INC. FOR SALT WATER DISPOSAL, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 701(B), Santa Fe Energy Resources, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on January 12, 1999, for permission to complete for salt water disposal its Old Ranch Canyon '7' Federal Well No. 5-Y (API No. 30-015-30653) located 1315 feet from the North line and 2315 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 7, Township 22 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:

(1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations;

(2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified;

(3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met; and,

(4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The applicant herein, Santa Fe Energy Resources, Inc. is hereby authorized to complete its Old Ranch Canyon '7' Federal Well No. 5-Y (API No. 30-015-30653) located 1315 feet from the North line and 2315 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 7, Township 22 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Devonian and Montoya formations at approximately 11,000 feet to 11,800 feet through 7-inch plastic-lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 10,900 feet.
