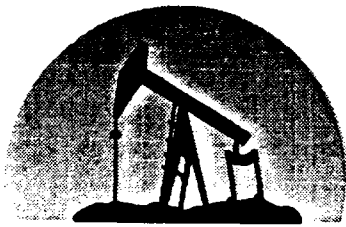

The proposed well, the New Mexico "CY" State No. 1 is located 1980 feet from the south line and 1650 feet from the east line.

Section 23, Township 17 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. Disposal water will be sourced from area wells producing from the Seven Rivers, Grayburg, San Andres, and Yeso formations. The disposal water will be injected into the Pennsylvanian formation at a depth 8593'-8850'. A maximum surface pressure of 1718 psi, and a maximum rate of 10,000 BWPD. 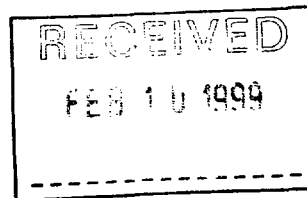

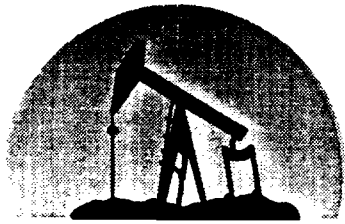

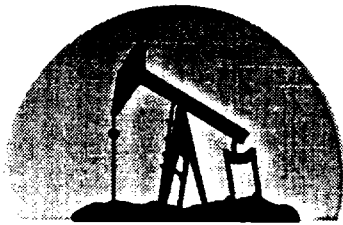
