

No. 2 Well in Section 19, T18S, R31E, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, forwarded to you herewith are:

- 1. The original Affidavit of Publication referenced in that Supplemental Application.
- 2. (Amended) Supplemental Application, which, as you will note, excludes the interval of 4800' 5050' for injection. This exclusion is made to resolve the objection of Concho Resources, as set forth in Tom Kellahin's letter to you of November 22. 
