The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas – 71629) and West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs (Gas – 79640) Pool production from the following leases:

Lease: Burnham Gas Com B FC Lease Well No. 1 (API No. 30-045-30219)
Description: W/2 of Section 12, Township 29 North, Range 13 West, NMPM; and

Lease: Burnham Gas Com A Lease Well No. 1 (API No. 30-045-29226)
Description: NW/4 of Section 12, Township 29 North, Range 13 West, NMPM;

located in San Juan County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from each lease prior to commingling. Oil production will not be commingled.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.


REMARKS: The commingled production shall be delivered to the CDP meter located at the Burnham Gas Com A Well No. 1 in the NW/4 of Section 12, Township 29 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Aztec district office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling process.

PROVIDING: Like approval from the U.S. Bureau of Land Management is also required.
