LEASE:Federal Gas Com "1" Lease (Federal Lease No. NM-019414)DESCRIPTION:N/2 of Section 20, Township 32 North, Range 12 West, NMPM,
San Juan County, New Mexico

Well No. 1B, (API No. 30-045-30032) Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool Well No. 2, (API No. 30-045-29816) Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool

The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Basin-Fruitlad Coal (Gas – 71629) and Blanco-Mesaverde (Prorated Gas – 72319) Gas Pool production from the above mentioned lease and to determine production from each pool by separately metering the production from the Federal Gas Com "1" No. 1B utilizing an allocation meter and to determine the production from the Federal Gas Com "1" No. 2 by subtracting the Federal Gas Com "1" No. 1B production volume from the total sales volume, as determined from the gas sales meter.

Compressor fuel gas will be allocated to each well in accordance with the formula contained within the application to commingle.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled natural gas production shall be delivered to a gas sales meter located in Unit B of Section 20, Township 32 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Aztec District Office of the Division upon implementation of commingling operations.
