APPLICATION OF CAULKINS OIL COMPANY TO EXPAND ITS SOUTH BLANCO-TOCITO PRESSURE MAINTENANCE PROJECT IN THE SOUTH BLANCO-TOCITO OIL POOL IN RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order R-1191, Caulkins Oil Company has made application to the Commission on August 21, 1961, for permission to expand its South Blanco-Tocito Pressure Maintenance Project by the conversion to water injection of its Breech "A" Well No. T-207, located in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 10, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, South Blanco-Tocito Oil Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Now, on this 11th day of September, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-1191.
- 4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-1191.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced Pressure Maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Caulkins Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Tocito formation underlying its Pressure Maintenance Project by the conversion to water injection of its Breech "A" Well No. T-207, located in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 10, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, in the South Blanco-Tocito Oil Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Injection shall be through perforations from 6645 feet to 6661 feet.
