Dear Mr. LeMay:

Yates Petroleum respectfully requests administrative approval to commingle production from nine wells drilled on two leases into a common tank battery and to permit the production from one lease to be transported prior to measurement to another lease for storage there on. It is proposed to commingle the production from the Patriot AIZ Com #1, the Ross EG Fed Com #1, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 10 and the Voight AJD Com. #1 into a common storage facility located on the Ross EG Fed Com #3 location. A map labeled Attachment I is enclosed for your information.

The purpose of this off lease storage and surface commingling is to reduce operating costs for storage and treating and thereby extend the economic life of each well. Without approval for utilizing existing batteries on adjacent leases, it will become necessary to build separate facilities for each well. This will greatly increase costs and shorten the economic life of the well. Because working interests and royalty interests are different, each of the well's production will be metered separately prior to surface commingling. The production in all five wells will be from the same producing zone which is the Lower Canyon Dolomite. In accordance with the referenced Rules 303-B, 309-B and 309-C, the following diagrams, maps and well data are submitted for your information.

Attachment II - A diagram of the proposed measurement equipment, separators and storage tanks in accordance with the "Manual for Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."

Attachment III - Plats of the leases showing the wells and the formations in which they are completed or are proposed to be completed.

Attachment IV - Notice to lease interest owners of the proposal to commingle production.





The purpose of this off-lease storage and surface commingling is to reduce operating costs for storage and treating and thereby extend the economic life of each well. Without approval for utilizing the already existing battery facilities on an adjacent lease, separate facilities would have to be constructed for each of these wells. This would increase operating costs and shorten the economic life of each of the wells.

Because interests for the proposed wells are different from those from the lease where the proposed storage facilities are located, oil from each of the nine wells will be measured by positive displacement, temperature compensated, metering equipment prior to surface commingling. Gas from the wells will also be metered separately. This metering will ensure that all production from each of the wells is equitably accounted for with no significant effect on your revenue.

We would appreciate your returning an approved copy of this letter to us by August 15, 1992 in the enclosed self-addressed envelope. If we do not hear from you by that date, we will assume that you have no objections to our proposal, and will request approval from the Bureau of Land Management and the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for this proposed off-lease storage and surface commingling.

Dear Mr. Manus:

Yates Petroleum Corporation formally requests approval to commingle production on the surface from nine wells in the referenced North Dagger Draw Pool which would require off-lease storage and off-lease measurement for two of the wells. A detailed explanation, including maps and diagrams is enclosed for your information.

The proposal is to build a battery on the location of the Ross EG Federal Com #3 located 1980 FSL and 1980 FWL of Section 20, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, (marked in red on Attachment 1), and then commingle the production from the Ross EG Federal Com #1, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 10, the Voight AJD Com #1 and the Patriot AIZ Com #1 (marked in blue on Attachment I). Although the production will be commingled into a common battery, each individual well's production will be measured separately by positive displacement, temperature compensated metering equipment prior to commingling. This will ensure that all production from each well will be accounted for equitably. Attachment II is a diagram of the proposed metering facilities and the consolidated tank batteries, and identifies all equipment utilized.

Attachment III is a map showing the lease numbers and location of all leases and wells that will be connected to the proposed off-lease facility. The communitized leases are outlined in red.

This proposal is a result of the continuous development of our leases in the Dagger Draw Pool. The purpose of the off-lease storage and surface commingling is to reduce operating costs and capital costs for

storage and thereby extend the economic life of the well. We anticipate that each of these wells will produce on a daily average basis 200-300 BOPD, 500-600 BWPD and 500-750 MCFD. The oil will be stored in tanks and then sold and pipelined to a refinery, the water will be gathered in the Yates Water Disposal System and eventually be injected into disposal wells, and the gas will be gathered into a gas gathering system and then sold. All of these produced fluids will be metered before commingling. It is anticipated that by commingling production into consolidated battery a savings of \$50,000 per well will be realized.

Therefore, we respectfully request the approval to commingle these wells into a consolidated battery and utilize off-lease storage and measurement. If you need any further information please contact me.
