The production for both wells would be from the Grayburg Sand Pool in which Marathon has a 100% interest to depth of 5,500'. Well No. 11 in the Johnson "B" Federal A/C 1 lease is also a Grayburg well which is currently awaiting hook-up to the same production facilities. 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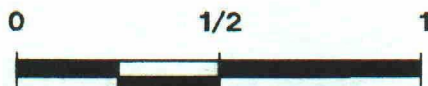
