Request for Approval to Surface Commingle the North Dagger Draw Upper Penn Production from the Lodewick A lease, NW/4 Section 19, T19S, R25E, and the Lehman Federal lease, SW/4 Section 18, T19S, R25E, Eddy County, New Mexico

Conoco Inc. requests approval to surface commingle the North Dagger Draw Upper Penn production from the subject leases. Conoco previously had approval to surface commingle all production in the Dagger Draw area under Commingling Order PLC-70. In September, 1987, Conoco requested an amendment to PLC-70 and at that time CTB-332 was issued. Conoco is again referencing PLC-70 due to the fact that all interest owners were contacted at that time and no disapprovals to our previous proposal were received.

Since both leases will be producing from the North Dagger Draw Upper Penn, the quality of the crude is expected to be identical and commingling will not reduce the commercial value. Also, the production from each lease will be metered separately at the battery using positive displacement temperature compensated meters for the oil and temperature compensated gas meters.

In addition, Conoco requests approval for off-lease storage for the Lehman Federal. The battery to be used for this proposed commingling is located at the Lodewick A No. 1, Unit C, Section 19, T19S, R25E.

Conoco's expenses for these leases will be reduced by combining production from them. This should allow each lease to have a longer economic life, thus generating more revenue to all interest owners. Mr. William LeMay Page 2 November 4, 1988





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

Application for Permission to Surface Commingle Production from All Conoco-Operated Leases in the Dagger Draw Area, Section 19, T-19S, R-25E, and Section 26, T-20S, R-24E, Eddy County, New Mexico

Conoco Inc. requests approval to surface commingle all Conoco-operated production in the Dagger Draw Area. Production in the north end of Dagger Draw will be commingled at a common tank battery located in the NE/4 of the NW/4 of Section 19, T-19S, R-25E, Eddy County. Production in the south end of Dagger Draw will be commingled at a common tank battery located in the SE/4 of the NW/4 of Section 26, T-20S, R-24E, Eddy County. In support thereof Conoco Inc. submits the following data.

- 1. The Dagger Draw Area consists of leases listed on Exhibit 1. Also shown on Exhibit 1 is the legal description and the producing formation for each well. Leases in the Dagger Draw Area are single well properties.
- 2. Exhibits 2 and 3 are maps showing each Conoco-operated lease in the Dagger Draw Area along with lease numbers and wells. Also shown are the locations of the proposed surface commingled tank batteries.
- 3. Quality of the crude is virtually identical and commingling will not reduce the commercial value. The value of the crude is as follows:

- 4. Oil production will be metered at each well using positive displacement temperature compensated metering equipment. Production will be allocated back to each lease based on metered volumes. Gas from each well will continue to be metered just as it is now.
- 5. A letter ballot dated May 9, 1984 was submitted to all working interest and royalty and overriding royalty interest owners requesting their approval or disapproval of this proposal. A no reply, as stated in the letter ballot, is considered as the interest owner's approval. Forty-nine out of 94 letter ballots were returned with affirmative replies. No disapprovals to our proposal were received.
- 6. Mineral rights under the Dagger Draw Area leases are held by Federal, State and Fee owners. Royalty owners are therefore varied. However, the metering of production at each lease will ensure proper royalty and overriding royalty disbursements to all interest owners.
- 7. A schematic of the existing treating and storage facilities are enclosed (Exhibit 4). These facilities will be expanded as each lease's production is brought to each location. Economic justification will determine what leases will be added to the existing facilities. Each lease will be evaluated separately to determine if economics justify adding the lease to the system. Therefore, no proposed treating and storage facility schematics are available. An updated schematic will be forwarded to your office as each lease is added to the facilities.

Conoco's expenses in the Dagger Draw Area can be reduced by combining production into two treating and storage facilities instead of the single well lease system currently being used. This will allow each well to have a longer economic life, thus generating more revenue to Conoco and to royalty and overriding royalty owners.
