

Tabor Gas Gathering System (Com 1E CDP @ NENE 2, T-29N, R-14W)

Dear Mr. Catanach, Mr. Lovato, and Mr. Martinez,

Attached for your information and file is a revised copy of the map for Dugan's Tabor Gas Gathering System. This map was presented as Attachment No. 1 in our 10/31/01 application to consolidate the King and Tabor Gas Gathering Systems and also as Attachment No. 1 in our 8/14/01 application to add nine wells to the Tabor Gas Gathering System.

The revised map presents a change in the location of the gas line connecting Dugan's Beyond Petroleum Com No. 90 (API No. 30-045-30769, located in the NWSW (Unit L) of Section 26, T-30N, R-14W) to the gathering system. Initially, it was planned to install the line to the south and connect with the Tabor Gathering System near Dugan's Jiggs #1 well in the SWNW of Section 35, T-30N, R-14W. We currently plan to install the gas line to the north and connect to the Tabor Gas Gathering System in the NENW of Section 26, T-30N, R14W near Dugan's Jacobs #3 well. I've highlighted the new line section in blue. There are no other changes to the map.
