The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Blinebry Oil & Gas (Oil – 6660), Blinebry Oil & Gas (Prorated Gas – 72480), Drinkard (Oil – 19190), Penrose Skelly-Grayburg (Oil – 50350), Tubb Oil & Gas (Oil – 60240), Tubb Oil & Gas (Prorated Gas – 86440), Wantz-Abo (Oil – 62700) and Eunice-San Andres (Oil – 24150) Pool production from the above mentioned lease and to determine production from each pool by monthly well tests.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled production shall be stored at a central tank battery located in the SW/4 of Section 34, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Hobbs District Office of the Division upon implementation of commingling operations.
