Gentlemen:

In accordance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule 309-B, Texaco Inc. respectfully requests permission to commingle production from the Eunice Monument Grayburg San Andres Pool on the B. M. Keohane "A" Lease with that from the B. M. Keohane "B" Lease in a tank battery located on the B. M. Keohane "B" Lease and to determine production from each well by periodic well tests.

Working interest and royalty interest ownership is common to both leases. In accordance with paragraph 4, Rule 309-B, all parties owning an interest in these leases and the Texas-New Mexico Pipeline Company have been notified by certified letter of our intention to commingle these leases.

A plat of the subject leases and a diagram of the proposed commingling facility is attached.

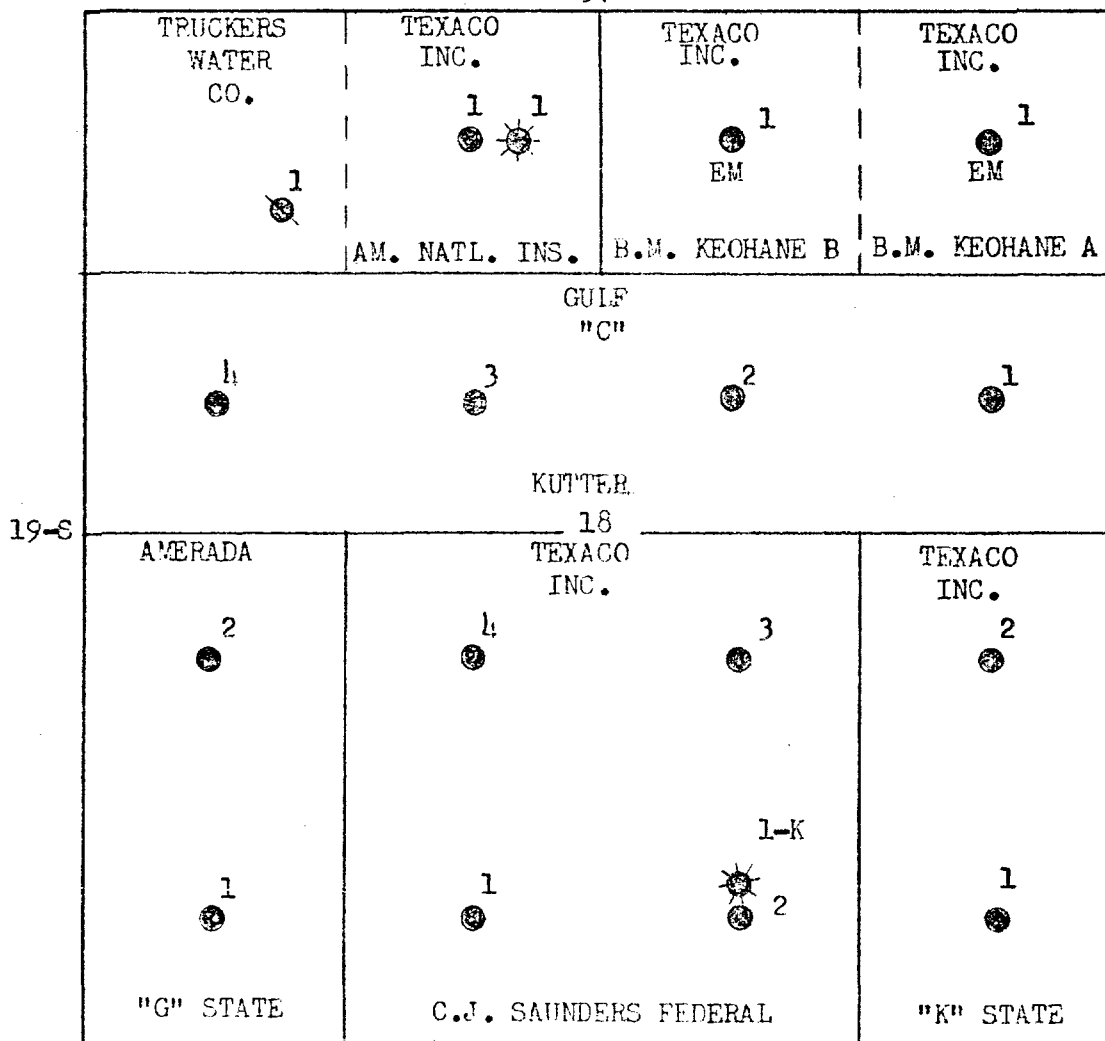

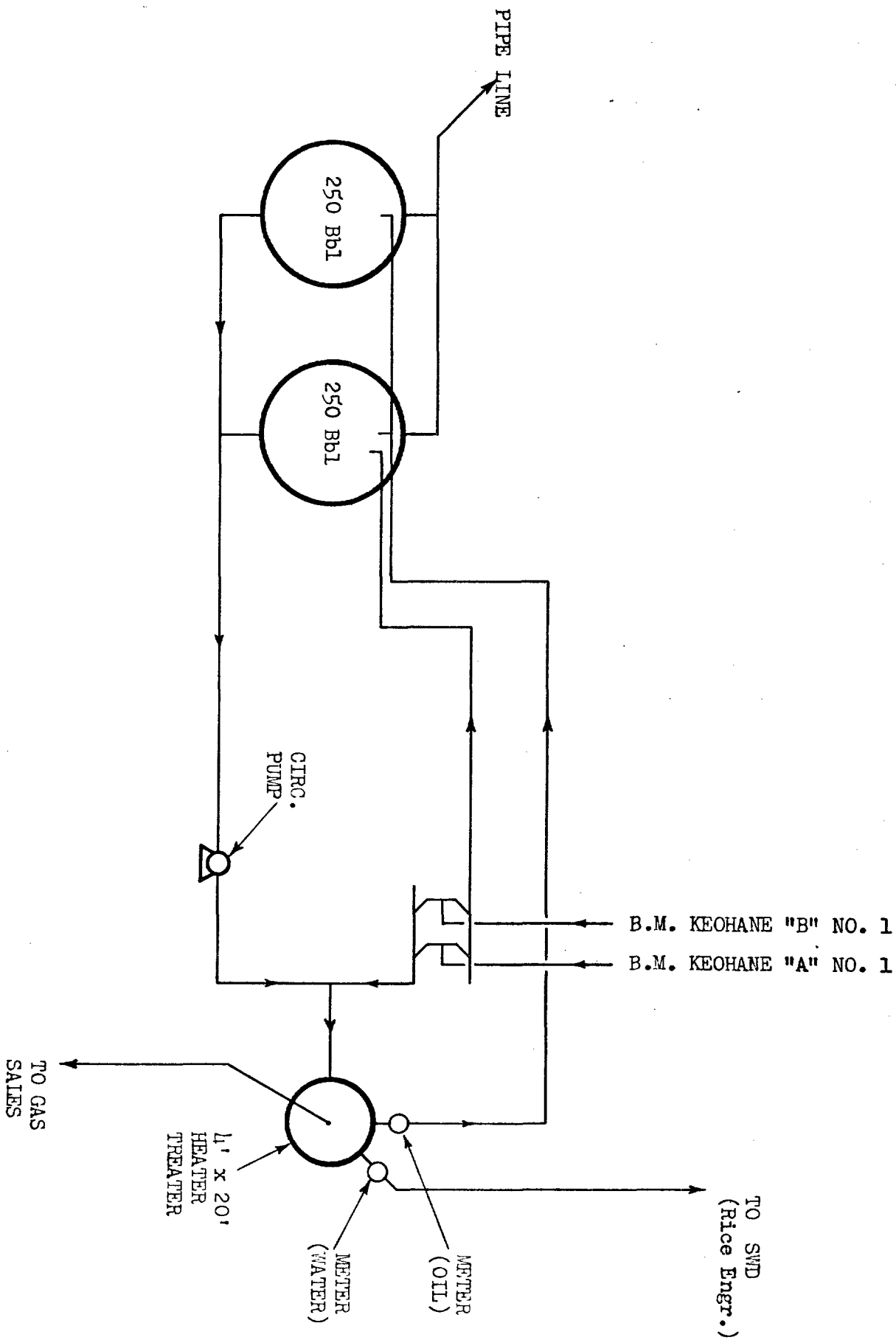
