



Gentlemen:

In accordance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule 309-B, TEXACO Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A to permit commingling of hydrocarbon production from the Vacuum North Abo Pool between New Mexico "D" State and New Mexico "T" State (NCT-3) Leases consisting of the S/2 of SE/4 of Sec. 28, T-17-S, R-34E and the W/2 of Sec. 27, T-17-S, R-34-E, Lea County, New Mexico.


The Working Interest and Royalty Interest are all common between leases. Therefore, it is proposed that the production of the New Mexico "T" State (NCT-3) Lease be routed to the central battery to be located on the New Mexico "D" State Lease and production be commingled. Production will be allocated to each lease on a periodic well test basis for which adequate well testing facilities will be provided. A schematic diagram of the proposed commingling installation and plat of the leases showing all wells and the formation in which they are completed are attached.

The State Land Office as Royalty Interest Owner and Mobil Pipeline Company as purchaser of Production are being furnished a copy of this application.

In view of the facts recited in this application, it is respectfully requested that administrative approval be granted TEXACO Inc. to permit the commingling into a common tank battery of hydrocarbon production from the Vacuum North Abo Pool from the New Mexico "D" State and "T" State (NCT-3) Leases.

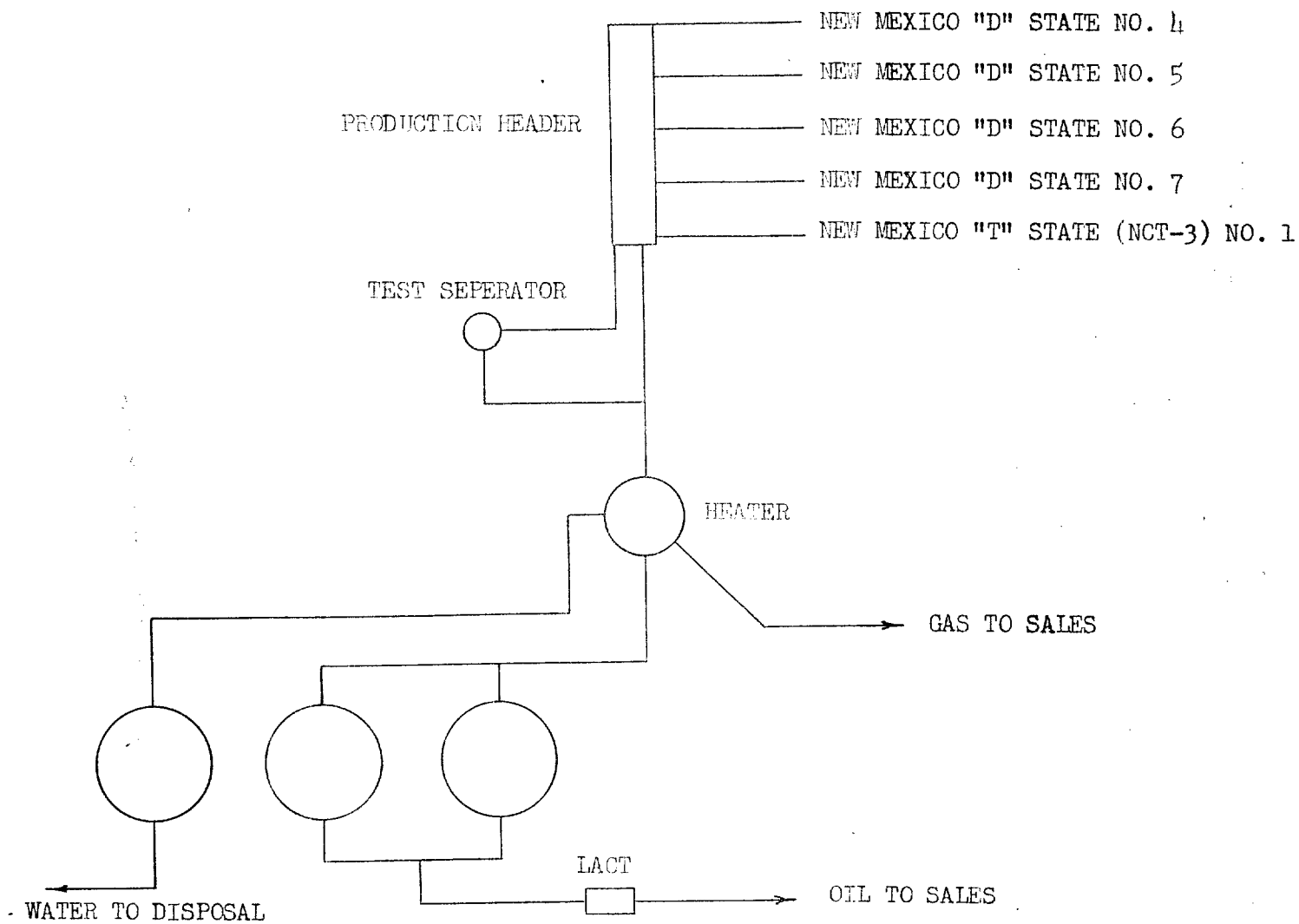
