0227 has filed Form C-108 (Application for Authorization to Inject) with New Mexico Oil the Division Conservation seeking administrative approval for a salt water disposal well. The proposed well, the State HU No. 1 is located 660' FSL and 2080' FWL, Section 7, Township 19 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. Disposal water will be sourced from area wells producing from the Morrow, and Atoka Strawn formations. The disposal water will be injected into the Upper Penn formation at a depth 8,850'-9400' at a maximum surface pressure of 1770 psi and a maximum rate of 10,000 BWPD.
