The above named company is hereby authorized to commingle production from the following pools and acreage within Section 26, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Jack Frost "A" No. 1
(Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool),

API No. 30-045-06267
NW/4 Dedication

Jack Frost "D" No. 1
Basin-Dakota (Prorated Gas 71599) Pool

API No. 30-045-06266
W/2 Dedication

The Jack Frost "A" No. 1 production shall be separately metered and the Jack Frost "D" No. 1 production determined by subtraction. Oil and water production shall not be commingled. **Compressor fuel gas usage shall be allocated according to well production rates.**

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled natural gas production shall be delivered to a gas sales meter located on the lease.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Aztec District Office of the Division upon implementation of commingling operations.
