Dear Mr. Carnes:

Reference is made to your request dated February 5, 2003, to increase the surface injection pressure on the above referenced well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on this well on February 3, 2003. The test results have been reviewed and we feel an increase in injection pressure is justified at this time.

Without modifying the injection interval or the tubing size or type, you are authorized to inject at

or below the following surface injection pressure.

Salty Dog Well No. 3R, Top Perforation 6,968 feet,	1,800 PSIG
Entrada Formation	0.26 psi/foot

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
