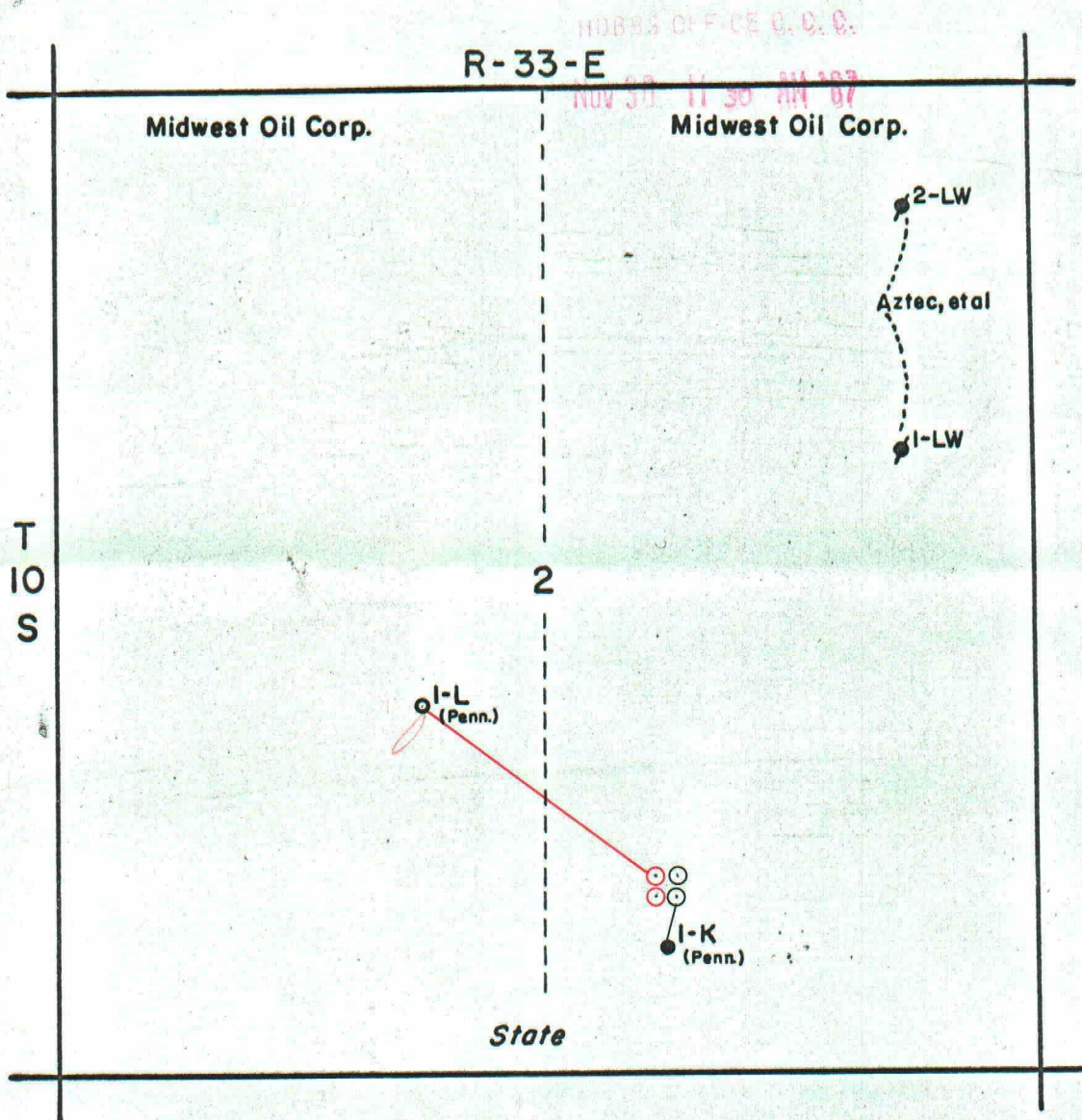

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

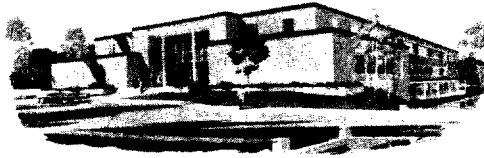
LOCATION OF WELLS

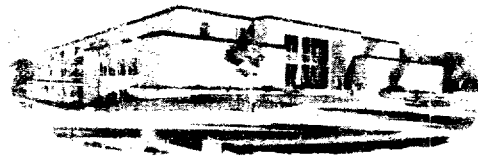

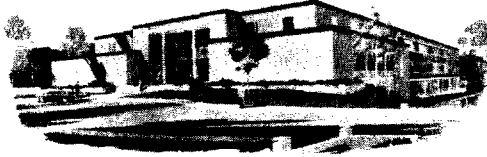

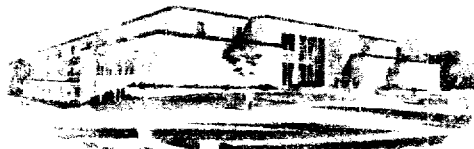
