Gentlemen:

Your letter of January 22 requests approval to modify the commingling system approved by our letter of October 13, 1964, lease Las Cruces 032100. Since well No. 3 has been recompleted in the Blinebry pool and it is capable of producing top allowable, you now propose to separately meter Blinebry production from well No. 3 prior to commingling with Drinkard, Tubb and other Blinebry production on the lease.

The proposed method of commingling is hereby approved. You are requested to notify our Hobbs office when the installation is completed so that a field inspection of the system can be made.
