Your letter of February 8 requests approval to modify the commingling system approved by our letter of February 1, 1965, lease Las Cruces 032100. You propose to discontinue separate metering of Blinebry production from well No. 3 prior to commingling with Drinkard, Tubb, and other Blinebry production on the lease and to determine production from each zone and each well on the basis of periodic well tests.
