A copy of this application has been su mitted to all royalty owners for approval. Any other pertinent information will be furnished upon request.

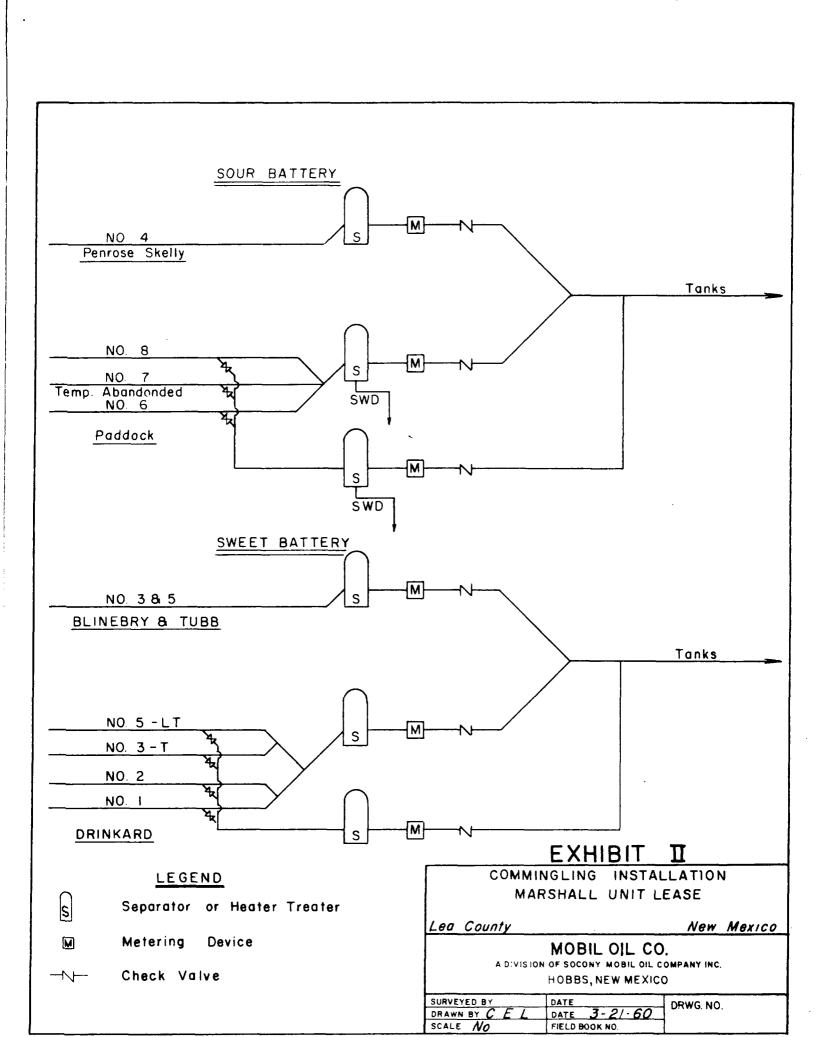

It may be noted that due to commingling the value of crude produced is increased \$0.36 per day for the sour crude battery and is increased \$3.16 per day for the sweet crude battery. This is an increase of \$3.52 daily or a monthly revenue increase of \$109.12 on a 31 day monthly basis.
