Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the liquid hydrocarbon production from the South Salt Lake Pennsylvanian Pool and an undesignated Atoka Pool from all wells presently completed or hereafter drilled on that portion of the State "CH" lease consisting of the SW/4, NW/4 SE/4 and the E/2 E/2 of Section 36, Township 20 South, Range 32 East and the N/2 N/2, SE/4 NE/4 and the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 31, Township 20 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the oil from the South Salt Lake Pennsylvanian Pool and an undesignated Atoka Pool from all wells presently completed or hereafter drilled on the above-described portion of the State "CH" lease, after separately metering the production from each pool.
