AMENDMENT  
Administrative Order PC-14-A

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of June 28, 1963, wherein you requested an amendment to Administrative Order PC-14-A to delete the requirement that production from the pools authorized to be commingled by said order must be metered prior to said commingling. We have now received a copy of the approval to discontinue separate metering from the United States Geological Survey.

Inasmuch as Eumont, Penrose-Skelly, and Drinkard production on your C. P. Falby "b" Lease commingled under authority of Administrative Order PC-14-A is now marginal, you are hereby authorized to discontinue metering said production prior to commingling. Allocation of production to the three separate pools will be made on the basis of periodic well tests.
