Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of February 10, 1961, wherein you request that Administrative Order No. PC-19 be amended to permit direct connecting lines to be installed from the Abo header to the San Andres header in order to utilize a Common Test Metering Separator for both pools in the commingling installation. You further propose to use gas operated motor valves to prevent accidental flow of oil from one header to the other.

Inasmuch as this proposed installation appears to provide a safe and reliable means of commingling and of testing two pools by means of a single test separator, PC-19 is hereby amended by deletion of the phrase, "provided however, that all direct connecting lines from the Abo to the San Andres header lines must be deleted from your installation.
