Reference is made to your letter dated June 24, 1965, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-28 which order authorized the commingling of Monument, Monument Blinebry, and Monument Paddock production on your J. R. Phillips Lease comprising the NW/4 of Section 6, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately measuring the production from each pool.

It is our understanding that all production from each of the aforesaid pools is of marginal nature and that you now wish to commingle, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-28 is hereby amended to delete the measurement requirement, provided, however, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in any of the aforesaid pools is capable of top allowable production.
