Amendment Administrative Order PC-29

R.

Reference is made to your letter of August 31, 1965, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-29, which as amended authorizes the commingling of Blinebry and Drinkard production on that portion of your A. H. Blinebry NCT-1 Lease comprising the N/2 N/2 of Section 29, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and Blinebry, Drinkard, and Tubb condensate from that portion of said lease comprising the S/2 NW/4 of said Section 29, after separately metering the production from each pool in each portion of said lease.

It is our understanding that you now have Tubb oil production on that portion of the lease comprising the N/2 N/2 of Section 29, and that you wish Administrative Order PC-29 further amended to include said Tubb oil production in the commingling authority.

Administrative Order PC-29 as amended is hereby further amended to include, the aforesaid Tubb oil production, provided, however, that all production from each pool in each portion of said lease shall continue to be separately metered prior to commingling.
